



Residential Fire Sprinkler System Giveaway

The purpose is to enhance the overall fire safety of a residence, to minimize the direct and indirect impact of a residential house fire by providing the means to limit the growth of a hostile fire and allow the occupants time to escape, and to help educate the public on the benefits of residential fire suppression sprinkler systems.

Fire District 3 encourages residential fire sprinkler systems due to their ability to react quickly and dramatically reduce the spread of heat, flames and smoke in the home.

According to the Oregon Fire Sprinkler Coalition

- If you have a fire in your home, the risk of dying decreases by about 80 percent when sprinklers are present.
- Sprinklers reduce direct property damage by about 70 percent per fire.
- Home sprinkler systems respond quickly to reduce the heat, flames, and smoke from a fire, giving families valuable time to get to safety.
- Roughly 85 percent of the time, only one sprinkler operates.
- Each individual sprinkler is designed and calibrated to go off when it reaches a predetermined temperature.
- Typically only the sprinkler closest to the fire will activate and spray water.

Entry Requirements

Application Process

- You must own a home inside Fire District 3 boundaries
- Submit a completed entry form
- Allow the selection committee to conduct a home visit
- Allow media coverage before, during and after installation

Timeline For Application

- Application period opens at 3:00 p.m. on November 10, 2015
- Application period closes at 4:00 p.m. on January 18, 2016
- Applications will be screened and scored by January 21, 2016
- The top three homeowners will be notified by January 25, 2016 for a home visit
- Final awardee will be notified by February 1, 2016

The final awardee will receive the complete design and installation of a residential fire sprinkler system, in accordance with national standards, in a single family residence.

Fire District 3 reserves the right to modify the listed dates and process as necessary or cancel this giveaway program at any time without notice. The top three entries will be notified of their status and all applications will become the sole property of Fire District 3 and will not be sold, transferred or open to any other agency, company, or person.
