Let's get started!

PHASE I

- Apply for admission to Rogue Community College and complete any required placement tests.
- Apply to Firefighter I Academy (**Due May 1st**).
- Applicants go through testing, interviews, and placement process with various Fire Districts in May.

We're happy to help you with any questions you may have about your application!

PHASE II

You'll be invited to participate in the testing, interview and placement process with local Fire Districts in May.

Successful candidates accepted into the student FF Academy enter into backgrounds and onboarding.

- Start date is Fall term. Student firefighters complete Firefighter Academy during this term.
- Winter term (January) students are assigned to a crew. 24-hour shifts on followed by 96 hours (4-days) off while still attending RCC classes.
- This continues for remaining time until degree completion.
- Students are encouraged to work at ODF in summer.

This is a 2 year commitment. If you are selected as the next student firefighter, Fire District 3 pays up to \$5250 per calendar year for each student...
This covers tuition, most fees, and books!

What you can expect: During this 2 year journey, you can gain the education, certifications and hands on experience to become a qualified candidate for hire in the Fire Service.
