A Guide to determining if your client is in Jackson County Fire District 3 and whether they are an ISO Class 3, 4 or 10

Dear Insurance Representative,

In an effort to reduce the impact on Fire District 3's limited resources this guide was developed to help you, the Insurance Representative, answer the two questions we get many times a day:

1. Is my client's property within Fire District 3?
2. What is the ISO Class of my client?

Please take the time to learn how to use "Jackson County Front Counter" to identify whether the property in question is in Fire District 3's boundaries. From there it's just a MapQuest exercise. Enter the address of your client and that of the nearest fire station to assess whether they are within 5 miles of the nearest station. If they are within 5 miles they are an ISO Class 4. If they are not they are an ISO Class 10. Neighboring jurisdiction's fire stations count too. We've listed our 7 fire station's addresses at the end of this guide for your reference. Also if your property address is within 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant you will be an ISO Class 3. Please help us to manage our workload by utilizing this guide to address your client's needs.

Using Jackson County's Front Counter

1. Identify the complete and accurate address of the client
2. Go to: <http://web.jacksoncounty.org/pdo/>
3. Click the dark blue "SEARCH" tab
4. Enter the address in Section 3
5. Click the grey "SUBMIT" box
6. If the search results show 3 options
 - a. Only house #
 - b. Only sites address
 - c. Both # and StreetTry each one until your client's property comes up.
7. Click "View Assessment and Planning Details"
8. Next click the grey box "overlay report"
9. Scroll down to "Fire Districts" box. If district 3 is listed your client is in JCFD3.

Determining your Client's ISO Classification

Jackson County Fire District 3 members are either a 3, 4 or a 10 class:

Within 1000 feet of a working fire hydrant = Class 3

5 or less miles from the nearest fire station = Class 4

More than 5 miles from the nearest fire station = Class 10

1. To determine the ISO Classification go to "MapQuest—Directions";
2. Enter your clients address on one side and the nearest fire station's address on the other.
3. Click directions and you get the distance between the two.
